**12. Maximum Entry:** Competitors and staff ratio is 1:1. It is also allowed to enter one additional coach or manager for each Pair or Team category, i.e. a country has 7 athletes competing with 1 Team and 1 Pair BC3, the maximum staff is 9.

**13. Entry fee:** Euro 1500 per athlete/team staff/manager. It covers:

- Accommodation (See Part II)
- Farewell Dinner (on 27<sup>th</sup> September)
- Transportation (See Part II)
- BISFed Capitation fees (Euro 50 per person)
- Optional half day sightseeing/shopping

**\*A surcharge of €500 will be added to the regular entry fee for each extra staff.**
